

Accessing capital for low-carbon materials

The Sustainable Concrete Buyers Alliance, or SCoBA, is a buyers alliance of leading organizations seeking to procure low-carbon cement and concrete. As the first group to collectively procure environmental attribute certificates (EACs) for low-carbon cement and concrete through a book and claim model, SCoBA aggregates demand through competitive procurement. This collective procurement from ambitious buyers enables pioneering producers to bridge the green premium and invest in low-carbon production at scale.

For producers, SCoBA provides:

- Access to committed buyers and larger volume commitments with one proposal
- New revenue streams through EACs to enable product decarbonization
- A pathway to help bridge green premiums
- Market credibility and visibility with leading global buyers

Participating in SCoBA procurements

Producers can participate by responding to SCoBA RFIs and subsequent RFPs issued by RMI and GMA, which define specific emission reduction goals, production quantities, contract length, or other criteria for EAC procurement of ambitious low-carbon products. Following the RFI and RFP process, SCoBA organizers evaluate submissions and shortlist qualified producers based on the defined procurement criteria.
