The Sustainable Concrete Buyers Alliance, or SCoBA, is a buyers alliance that enables companies to access low-carbon procurement opportunities for cement and concrete to reduce Scope 3 emissions through environmental attribute certificate (EAC) purchases.

- Warehousing companies
- Corporations with concrete-intensive supply chains

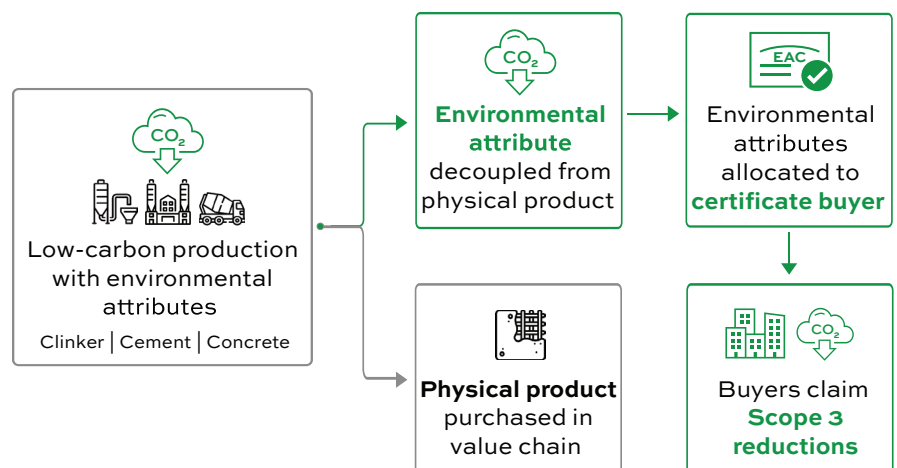

How SCoBA can reduce Scope 3 emissions:
