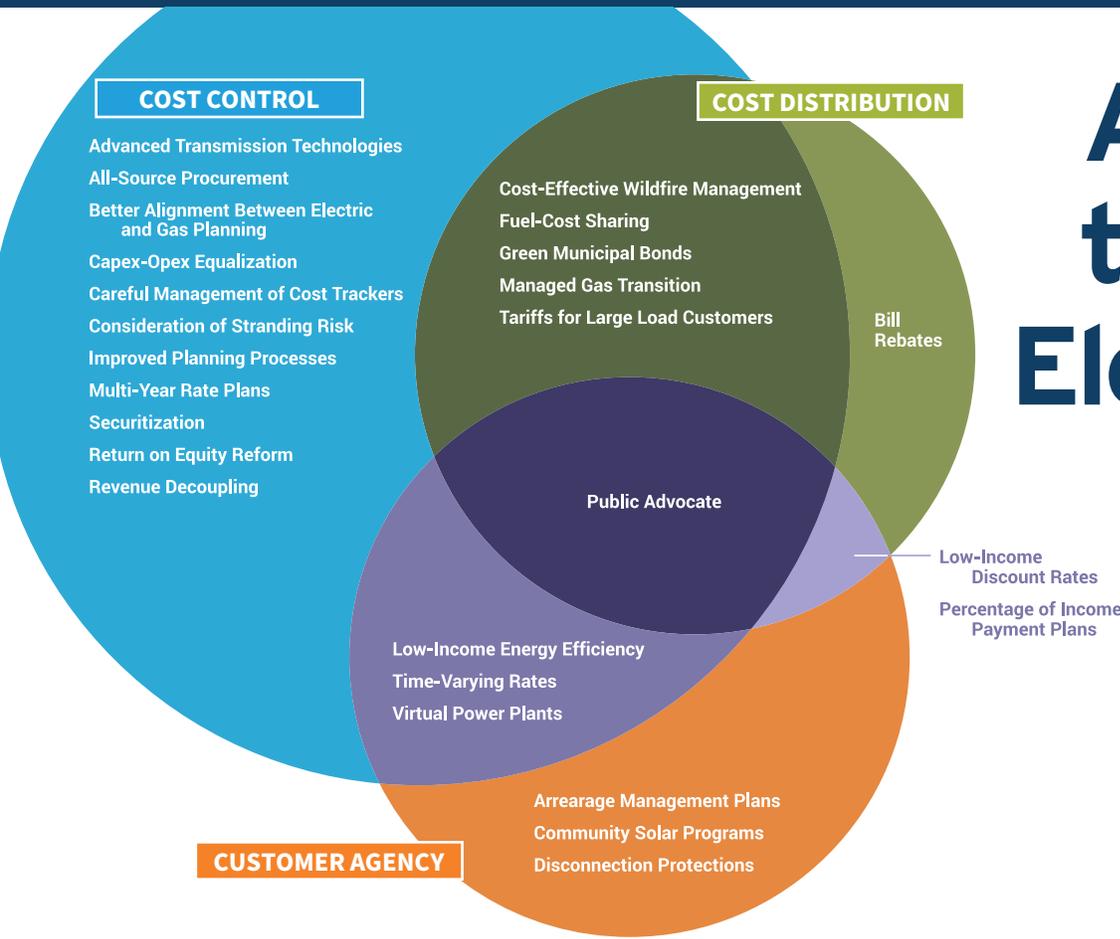


A Toolkit to Tackle Electricity Costs



A Decisionmaker's Guide to Affordability

[This toolkit](#) features over two dozen state policies to advance electricity affordability. It allows policymakers and advocates to filter the policies to identify the ones that are best aligned with state context and goals and then explore information on each policy, including potential impact, real world examples, and policy design considerations.

Designed primarily to inform legislative action, it includes information relevant to regulators, consumer advocates,

administration officials, and more.

Each policy solution is categorized according to three overarching themes: cost control, cost distribution, and customer agency, which together form a comprehensive framework for understanding and addressing electricity

affordability. A subset of the policies are specifically designed to safeguard vulnerable customers.

Use the toolkit to understand the full range of levers that can be used to promote affordability, to give your legislators an easy-to-use summary of one or more specific policies (downloadable PDFs are available), and

to better understand the role of different decisionmakers in deploying affordability solutions.
