Puerto Rico Resilient Schools Microgrid Project, Phase I (Comerio, Aguas Buenas, and Corozal)

<u>Summary</u>

Rocky Mountain Institute (RMI) is partnering with Save the Children to develop solar-plus-storage microgrid projects at up to 12 public schools in communities severely impacted by Hurricane Maria. This document announces that RMI will release a Request for Proposals (RFP) on **Friday, November 9, 2018** aiming to provide resilient, renewable energy systems at **three** schools to support their continued operation following future storms and extended power outages. RMI will conduct mandatory site visits on **Tuesday, November 13, 2018**. The schools in question are located in the municipalities of Comerio, Aguas Buenas, and Corozal, and this project will affect over 990 elementary and middle school students.
