Puerto Rico Resilient Schools Microgrid Project, Phase II (Morovis, Canovanas, Humacao, Naranjito, Barranquitas, Jayuya)

Summary

Rocky Mountain Institute (RMI) is partnering with Save the Children to develop solar-plus-storage microgrid projects at up to 12 public schools in communities severely impacted by Hurricane Maria. This document announces that RMI will release a Request for Proposals (RFP) on **Wednesday, April 3, 2019** aiming to provide resilient, renewable energy systems at six schools to support their continued operation following future storms and extended power outages. RMI will conduct mandatory site visits for five of the six schools on **Tuesday and Wednesday, April 9 and 10**. The schools in question are located in the municipalities of Morovis, Canovanas, Humacao, Naranjito, and Barranquitas. The site visit to the Jayuya school will not be mandatory and can be arranged for April 11th if the installer requests it.

Your presence at the site visit is mandatory (except for the visit to the Jayuya school) for your participation in this competitive RFP process. Please confirm your participation in the Site Visit by noon Eastern Time on **Friday, April 5th**. RMI will respond to your confirmation with the details of the site visit.
